Competition Information

National middle distance Saturday April 5, 2008

- General** Welcome to Sävedalens AIK and Göteborgsdubbeln 2008 in Åstebo!
Please be careful in the forest, not only towards nature and the environment, but also towards other people in the terrain and the guests of the hostel and other buildings at the event centre. **The lawn in front of the hostel is prohibited area.**
- Event centre** Kåsjön/Åstebo. **Road markings from the road between Partille and Landvetter and from road E20, exit 81 Skulltorpsmotet.** You can also go by public bus, line 513, to bus stop Åstebo, distance to event centre 250 m.
- Parking** Max 800 m from event centre. Parking fee 10 SEK. Clubs travelling in large coaches are requested to notify this to jan.olsson@vxu.se.
Please note that passing the tunnel under the Landvetter road is prohibited because it leads through the competition area. Be sure to follow the signs from the parking area!
- Start lists** Start lists will be published at the event website at www.saik.o.se/arrangemang/080405/.
- Start** First start at 11:00. Runners with late entries will start before this time. U classes, Open classes and Inskolning have punch start at any chosen time between 10:30 and 12:30. Youth classes up to and including HD16 may look at the map 1 minute before start, other classes takes the map at start moment. B/W follower maps are available for classes Inskolning, U1 and U2. **Distance to start for all classes 300 m, orange-white markings.**
- Clothing** All participants must wear clothes covering the full body with exception of head, neck and arms according to rules of the Swedish Orienteering Federation (SOFT).
- Bib numbers** Bib numbers are mandatory in classes H21E, D21E, H20E, D20E, H18E and D18E. Self service at start.
- Clothing transport** Because of the short distance to start we will not transport any clothing.
- Open classes** Registration to Open classes (Ö1, Ö2, Ö4, Ö5, Ö7 and Ö8) and Inskolning at the event centre between 10:00 and 12:00. Start for these classes by punch start any chosen time between 10:30 and 12:30.
- Merged classes** Classes D75 and D80 are merged into D75.
- Cancelled classes** H55M, H20, D21M, D20 and U4.

Punch system	<p>SportIdent. If you have not registered a SI-card number with your entry, you will be assigned to a rented SI-card which can be picked up at the open classes register tent. Rental fee for a SI-card is 25 SEK. A non returned card will be charged with 300 SEK. Note - SportIdent's new SI-card 8 and SI-card 9 cannot be used at this event; if you have one of these you will be assigned a rented SI-card without charge.</p> <p>If any SI post does not beep or blink, punch in the reserve squares on the map and report at the finish.</p> <p>Check the start list that you have the right SI-card number registered, otherwise contact the event expedition at the finish before starting. The SI-cards are cleared on the way to start and will be checked when entering the start.</p>
Map	<p>Kåsjön-Råhult. The map is revised during autumn 2007 by KARTSAM. Digital print using a SOFT-certified printer in scale 1: 10 000 and equidistance 5 m. Maps are put in plastic bags, for all classes.</p>
Post definitions	<p>Post definitions are printed on the map. Separate definitions are available at start.</p>
Terrain	<p>The terrain consists of moderate to steep hills (sparsely), mainly covered by forest with many paths. The forest is mainly mixed but also some parts with large spruces almost no undergrowth. The terrain is mainly easily navigable but is locally not so good because of wet marshes and dense heather or uneven ground. After the mild winter, it is very wet in the terrain and at some paths. The posts are very close in many places. Please check the post-ID.</p>
Wildlife	<p>Please report at the finish if you see any elks, deer or wild boars.</p>
String-O	<p>String-O for small children is arranged from 10:30 to 12:30 with start and finish at the event centre. Cost 10 SEK, bring a SI-card.</p>
Prizes	<p>Prize ceremonies when the classes are complete. This will be announced by the event speaker.</p>
Shower	<p>Tempered outdoor shower, 300 m from event centre.</p>
Toilets	<p>Only at the event centre, situated at the way to start.</p>
Medical service	<p>At the event centre close to the finish.</p>
Cafeteria	<p>At the event centre.</p>
